



## IRL-FCLA Visiting Scientist Program Application

The FCLA Visiting Scientist Program is now open for application.

The FCLA (Franco-Chilean Laboratory for Astronomy) is an international research laboratory (IRL 3386) between the French “*Centre National de la Recherche Scientifique*” (CNRS) and the “*Universidad de Chile*”, the “*Pontificia Universidad Católica de Chile*”, and the “*Universidad de Concepción*” with the goal to promote and forge fruitful long-term collaborations between France and Chile in the field of Astronomy.

As such, the FCLA counts on the existence of a visiting program to support French and Chilean students and researchers for short/mid term stays and internships (typically 1-3 months, but any duration will be considered) in Chile or in France.

Applications must be jointly prepared and proposed by one member of the three Chilean universities and one French researcher/student from a CNRS Lab. Applications must be sent to the Deputy Director of the FCLA ([pasquier.noterdaeme@cns.fr](mailto:pasquier.noterdaeme@cns.fr)). They will be reviewed by the FCLA board (Felipe Barrientos, Patricio Rojo, Neil Nagar, Martin Giard and Pasquier Noterdaeme). Proposals must be submitted at least three months before the proposed starting date, but we strongly encourage applicants to submit their project 6 months in advance for organizational aspects (flight ticket, hotel reservation...).
